contributes \$1.66 to the state economy.

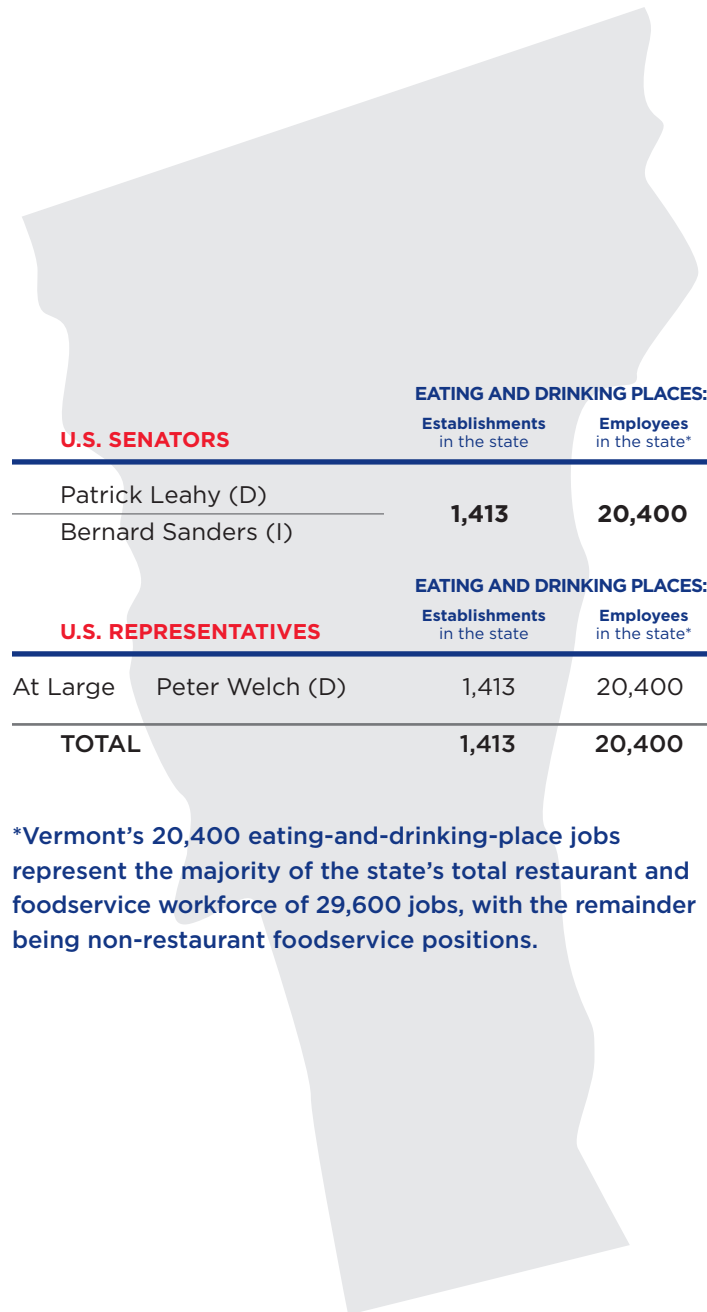
Every dollar spent in the limited-service segment
