

## ECONOMIC CONTRIBUTIONS

OF THE RESTAURANT & FOODSERVICE INDUSTRY



SUMMER 2025 In 2025, Alabama's eating and drinking places are projected to contribute **\$19.85B** in direct economic output to the state's economy, support **202,634** jobs, and deliver **\$5.68B** in total labor income, including wages, salaries, and proprietors' income, and benefits.

These contributions spur additional spending in the U.S. economy. When including indirect and induced impacts from employees, suppliers, and others in the surrounding area, the industry's total economic impact rises to \$31.85B in output, supporting 259,874 jobs, and \$9.03B in total labor income.

The industry will also be a major source of public revenue. Direct contributions will total **\$3.04B in taxes** to all levels of government, including \$157.20M in county taxes, \$999.17M in state taxes and \$1.31B in federal taxes. With induced and indirect effects included, total contributions will reach **\$4.46B in taxes**, with \$206.39M in county taxes, \$1.37B in state taxes and \$2.12B in federal taxes.









