SUMMER 2025 In 2025, lowa's eating and drinking places are projected to contribute **\$11.74B in direct economic output** to the state's economy, support **128,180 jobs**, and deliver **\$3.37B in total labor income**, including wages, salaries, and proprietors' income, and benefits.

These contributions spur additional spending in the U.S. economy. When including indirect and induced impacts from employees, suppliers, and others in the surrounding area, the industry's total economic impact rises to \$19.09B in output, supporting 161,431 jobs, and \$5.55B in total labor income.

The industry will also be a major source of public revenue. Direct contributions will total **\$1.55B in taxes** to all levels of government, including \$88.16M in county taxes, \$421.74M in state taxes and \$741.2M in federal taxes. With induced and indirect effects included, total contributions will reach **\$2.40B in taxes**, with \$123.99M in county taxes, \$622.54M in state taxes and \$1.24B in federal taxes.







