SUMMER 2025 In 2025, Kansas's eating and drinking places are projected to contribute **\$12.27B** in direct economic output to the state's economy, support **126,921 jobs**, and deliver **\$3.83B** in total labor income, including wages, salaries, and proprietors' income, and benefits.

These contributions spur additional spending in the U.S. economy. When including indirect and induced impacts from employees, suppliers, and others in the surrounding area, the industry's total economic impact rises to \$20.45B in output, supporting 162,786 jobs, and \$6.27B in total labor income.

The industry will also be a major source of public revenue. Direct contributions will total **\$1.89B in taxes** to all levels of government, including \$157.31M in county taxes, \$577.4M in state taxes and \$855.94M in federal taxes. With induced and indirect effects included, total contributions will reach **\$2.88B in taxes**, with \$211.19M in county taxes, \$827.94M in state taxes and \$1.44B in federal taxes.







