# ECONOMIC CONTRIBUTIONS OF THE RESTAURANT & FOODSERVICE INDUSTRY



MISSISSIPPI

SUMMER 2025

In 2025, Mississippi's eating and drinking places are projected to contribute **\$11.96B in direct economic output** to the state's economy, support **126,919 jobs**, and deliver **\$3.26B in total labor income**, including wages, salaries, and proprietors' income, and benefits.

These contributions spur additional spending in the U.S. economy. When including indirect and induced impacts from employees, suppliers, and others in the surrounding area, the industry's total economic impact rises to **\$18.69B in output**, supporting **159,896 jobs**, and **\$4.93B in total labor income**.

The industry will also be a major source of public revenue. Direct contributions will total **\$1.66B in taxes** to all levels of government, including \$117.35M in county taxes, \$603.19M in state taxes and \$740.17M in federal taxes. With induced and indirect effects included, total contributions will reach **\$2.46B in taxes**, with \$163.86M in county taxes, \$863.26M in state taxes and \$1.15B in federal taxes.

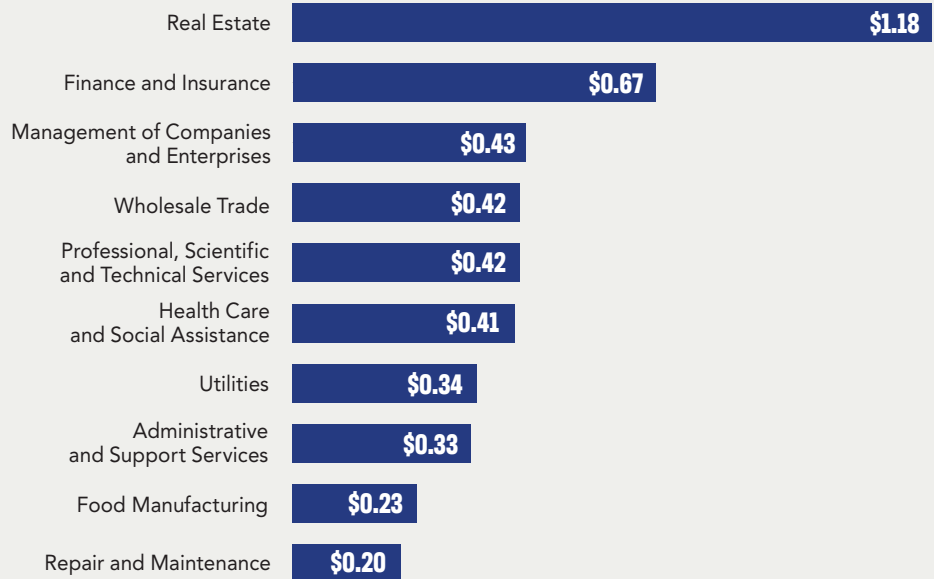

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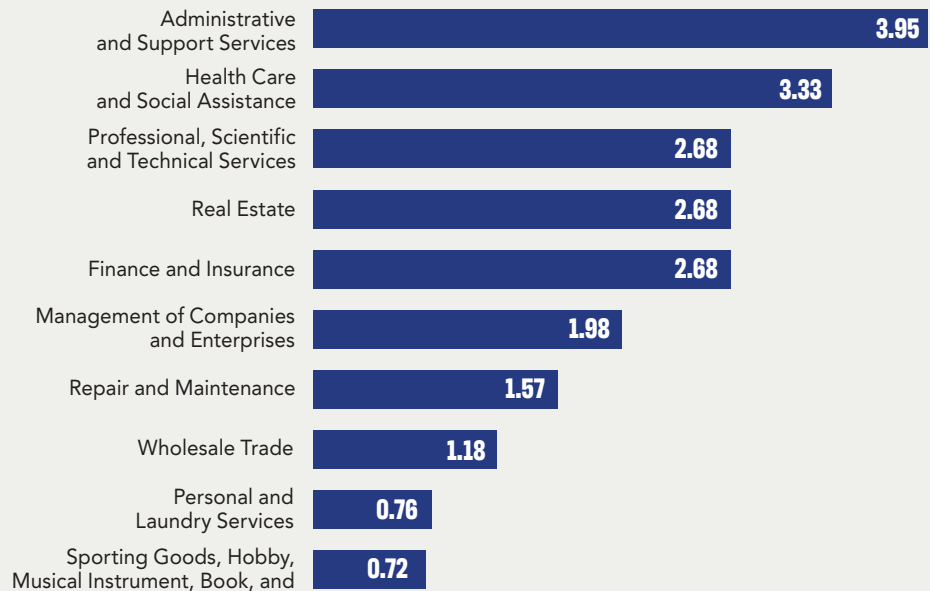
