SUMMER 2025 In 2025, North Dakota's eating and drinking places are projected to contribute **\$3.16B** in direct economic output to the state's economy, support **34,444** jobs, and deliver **\$971.44M** in total labor income, including wages, salaries, and proprietors' income, and benefits.

These contributions spur additional spending in the U.S. economy. When including indirect and induced impacts from employees, suppliers, and others in the surrounding area, the industry's total economic impact rises to **\$4.87B** in output, supporting **42,140** jobs, and **\$1.5B** in total labor income.

The industry will also be a major source of public revenue. Direct contributions will total **\$416.73M in taxes** to all levels of government, including \$12.2M in county taxes, \$148.38M in state taxes and \$211.89M in federal taxes. With induced and indirect effects included, total contributions will reach **\$584.83M in taxes**, with \$14.78M in county taxes, \$187.01M in state taxes and \$329.41M in federal taxes.







