SUMMER 2025 In 2025, Oregon's eating and drinking places are projected to contribute **\$19.11B in direct economic output** to the state's economy, support **186,218 jobs**, and deliver **\$6.94B in total labor income**, including wages, salaries, and proprietors' income, and benefits.

These contributions spur additional spending in the U.S. economy. When including indirect and induced impacts from employees, suppliers, and others in the surrounding area, the industry's total economic impact rises to \$33.09B in output, supporting 248,624 jobs, and \$11.77B in total labor income.

The industry will also be a major source of public revenue. Direct contributions will total **\$2.55B in taxes** to all levels of government, including \$76.18M in county taxes, \$548.71M in state taxes and \$1.61B in federal taxes. With induced and indirect effects included, total contributions will reach **\$4.50B in taxes**, with \$143.26M in county taxes, \$980.29M in state taxes and \$2.78B in federal taxes.






