SUMMER 2025 In 2025, Washington's eating and drinking places are projected to contribute \$36.36B in direct economic output to the state's economy, support 297,841 jobs, and deliver \$12.14B in total labor income, including wages, salaries, and proprietors' income, and benefits.

These contributions spur additional spending in the U.S. economy. When including indirect and induced impacts from employees, suppliers, and others in the surrounding area, the industry's total economic impact rises to \$61.58B in output, supporting 392,703 jobs, and \$21.92B in total labor income.

The industry will also be a major source of public revenue. Direct contributions will total **\$7.07B in taxes** to all levels of government, including \$347.36M in county taxes, \$2.49B in state taxes and \$3.12B in federal taxes. With induced and indirect effects included, total contributions will reach **\$10.85B in taxes**, with \$463.27M in county taxes, \$3.36B in state taxes and \$5.53B in federal taxes.







