ECONOMIC CONTRIBUTIONS OF THE RESTAURANT & FOODSERVICE INDUSTRY

In 2025, Wyoming’s eating and drinking places are projected to contribute **\$2.63B in direct economic output** to the state’s economy, support **28,385 jobs**, and deliver **\$827.66M in total labor income**, including wages, salaries, and proprietors’ income, and benefits.

These contributions spur additional spending in the U.S. economy. When including indirect and induced impacts from employees, suppliers, and others in the surrounding area, the industry’s total economic impact rises to **\$3.77B in output**, supporting **33,977 jobs**, and **\$1.11B in total labor income**.

The industry will also be a major source of public revenue. Direct contributions will total **\$338.60M in taxes** to all levels of government, including \$11.85M in county taxes, \$92.40M in state taxes and \$210.63M in federal taxes. With induced and indirect effects included, total contributions will reach **\$470.36M in taxes**, with \$17.01M in county taxes, \$131.64M in state taxes and \$287.66M in federal taxes.

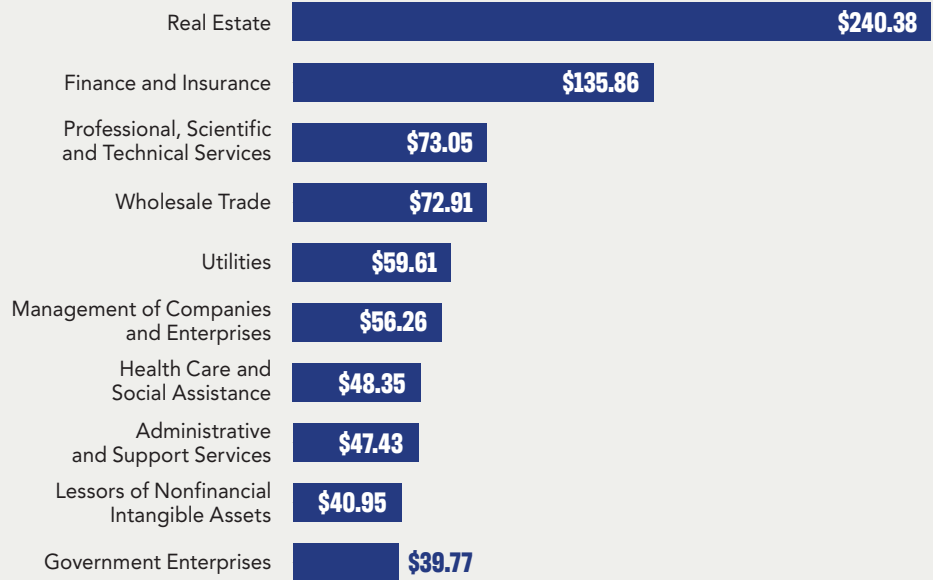
